Event centre

Camping Velkopa ezitý ásná

(GPS: 49°13´40.28" N, 15°23´3.92" E)

The Camp site is located about 1km away from a picturesque village ásná, in a heavily forested part of the SW Highlands, below its highest peak – Javo ice (837 m a.s.l.).

Travel information

By public transport (flight, train or bus): travel to Prague or Brno, then by bus to Tel. The organizer offers the assistance with finding the local travel information and also with the transportation from Tel. to the event site.

By car (see the map below): Use the D1 highway from Brno, leave at exit 112 (Jihlava) and continue southwards in direction T eš, Tel. From Wien, travel in direction Znojmo, Praha. 48 km behind Znojmo turn left on the road 23 and continue towards Tel.

The EYAC centre is located 8 km NW from Tel behind the village ásná (follow the EYAC signs).



Accommodation

4-bed high-standard bungalows equipped with WC, shower, kitchen unit and a fridge. Accommodation before and after the Championship is also available upon request.

Competition areas

are located within 10 km of the event centre. They are of medium difficulty, covered with forests, with dense path network. Maximum altitude difference is 120 m.

All forested area in the 10 km radius from the EYAC centre except for area on the training map provided by the organizer is declared as embargoed area. No training or survey is allowed in this area from now until the end of the second EYAC09 competition. The penalty for breaking of this rule will be disqualification.

Opportunity for training

close to the camping site. There will be installed several transmitters at each band. Training maps will be provided for each participant.

International rules

apply for Youth ARDF Championships on the 144 MHz and 3.5 MHz bands for the categories W15 and M15. Only competitors born in 1994 or later are allowed to participate. Each country may nominate up to 6 competitors in each category in total. The number of officials and visitors is not limited.

Ranking

individuals and teams in each competition and each age category.

Technical parameters of the equipment

- 3,5 MHz transmitters:
 - RF power 3W
 - frequency: MOE-MO5 3580kHz, MO 3550kHz
 - antenna: 8m vertical + 8m counterpoise
- 144 MHz transmitters:
 - RF power 3W PEP
 - frequency: MOE-MO5 144,55MHz, MO 144,85MHz
 - antenna: crossed dipoles 3m above the ground level

Registering equipment

SportIdent system. Competitors are kindly asked to provide their SI-card numbers in the application form. Those who do not have their own SI-card may rent the SI-card at the registration. The 50,- CZK rental fee will be required at the registration desk. The rented SI-cards will be collected at the finish after the second competition. Competitors with rented SI-cards who do not return them will be charged for a replacement.

Medical information

There will be first aid facility at the finish area during both competitions. If you have a known allergy to insect stings or bites and have an EpiPen with you, please carry it on your person during the competitions.

For minor injuries such as scrapes, small cuts or bruises, treatment may be carried out on-site. There is no cost to the participant for on-site minor treatment; however the cost for ambulance transportation, emergency department visits and clinic visits will be the participant's responsibility. We recommend you to establish an insurance covering such expenses.

Clothing

There are no restrictions on the type of footwear or clothing to be worn. However, clothing covering elbows and knees is recommended.

The citizens of most of countries expected to take part in the Championship do not need visa to enter the Czech Republic. Those societies that need visa will be informed after receiving their Letter of Intent.
