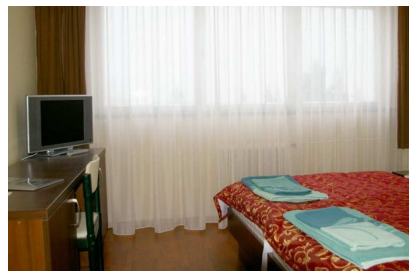
Event centre:

Bojnice, hotel Damona Regia. Spa town Bojnice is located in the middle of Slovakia, near Prievidza, 190 km northeast from Bratislava and 70 km south from Zilina.



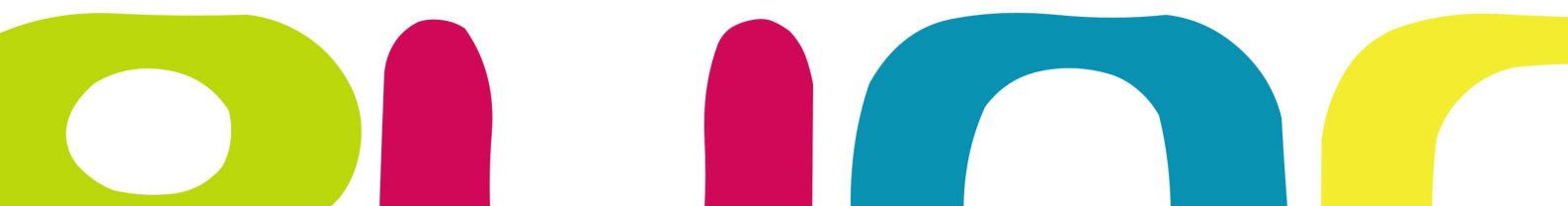
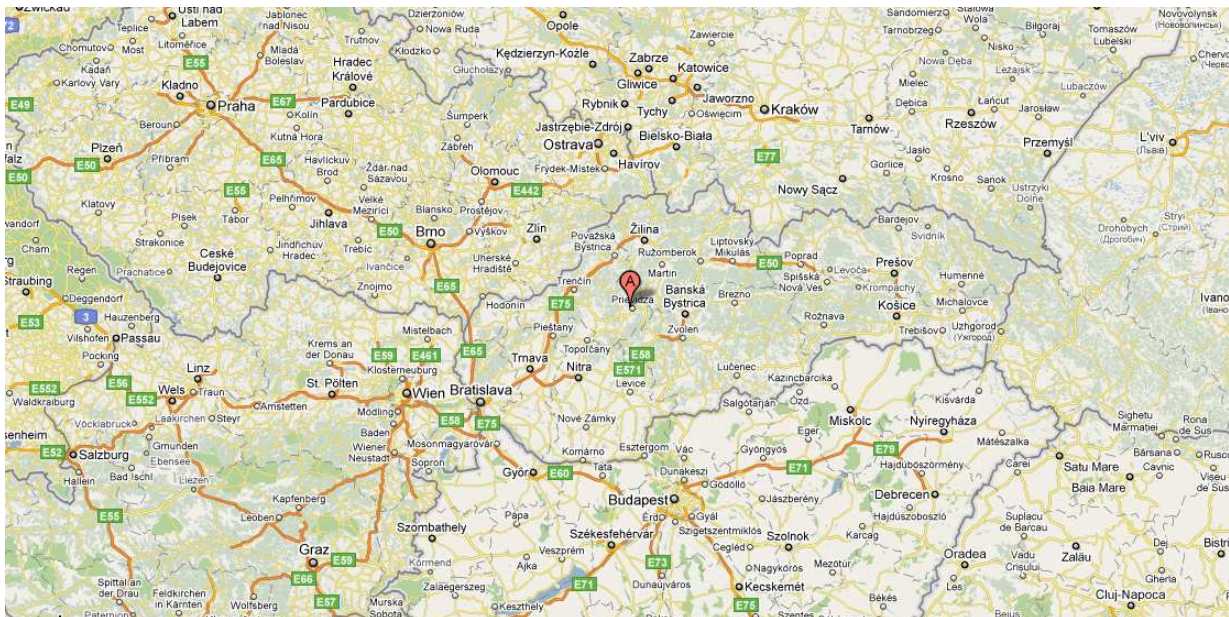
Accommodation:

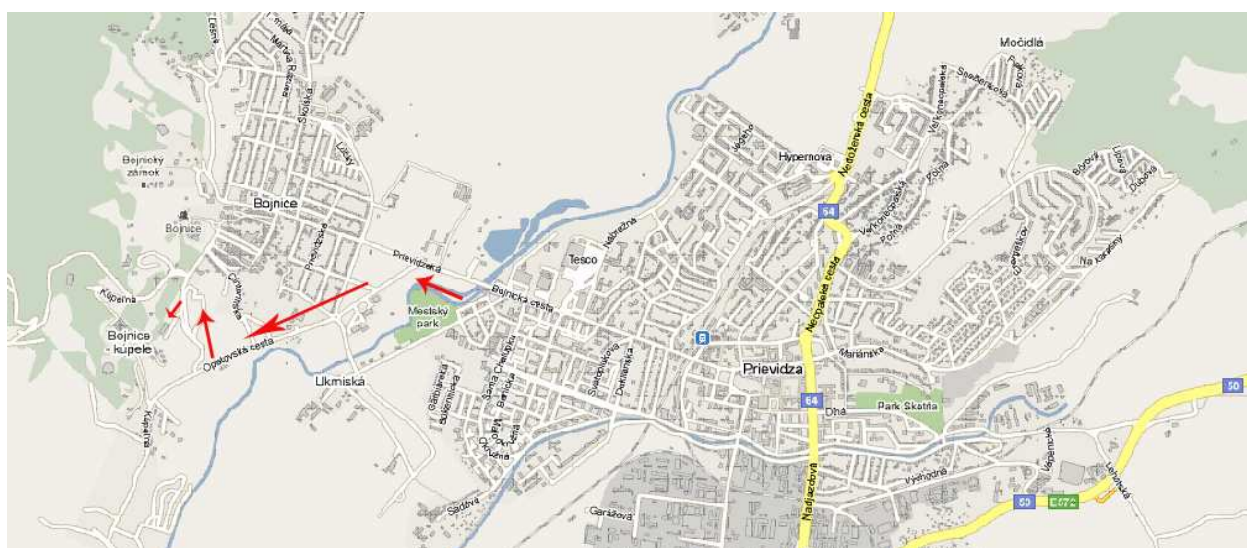
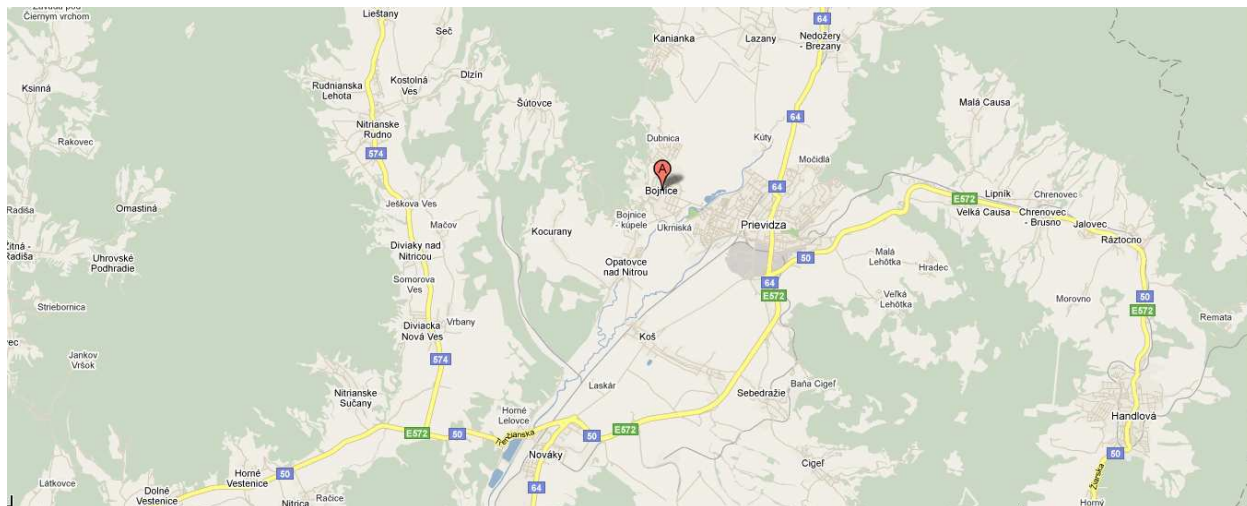
2- and 3-bed hotel rooms. The rooms are equipped with shower, WC, TV and a phone. You can connect to the internet via wireless (free of charge).



Travel information:

Hotel Damona Regia - the event centre is located in southern part of Bojnice (see signs on the maps).





Competition areas:

All competition areas are located within 10 km of the event centre.

All forested areas in the 10 km radius from the EYAC centre except for area on the training map provided by the organizer is declared as embargoed area. No training or survey is allowed in this area from now until the end of the second EYAC 2010 competition. The penalty for breaking of this rule will be disqualification.

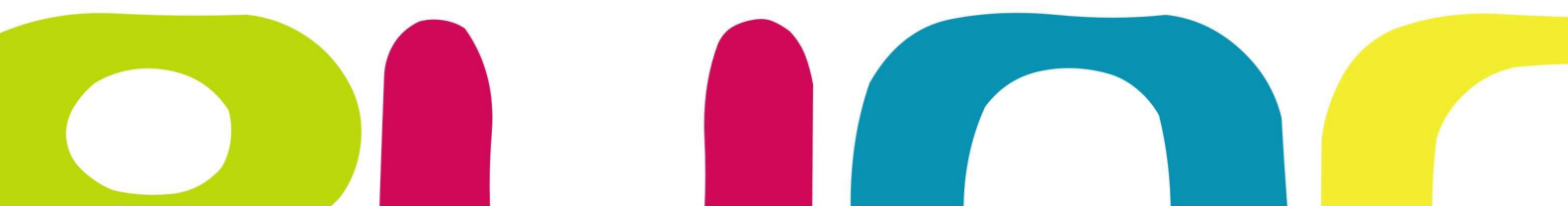
Training:

Opportunity for training will be close to the camping site. There will be installed several transmitters at each band. Training maps will be provided for each participant.

Competition rules:

International rules for Youth ARDF Championships on the 144 MHz and 3,5 MHz band for categories W15 and M15 will be applied. Only competitors born in 1995 or later are allowed to participate.

Ranking: individuals and teams



Technical parameters of the equipment:

3,5 MHz transmitters:

- RF power 3 W
- frequency: MOE-MO5 3580 kHz, MO 3550 kHz
- antenna: 6m vertical + 6m counterpoise

144 MHz transmitters:

- RF power 1 W
- frequency: MOE-MO5 144,800 MHz, MO 144,500 MHz
- antenna: crossed dipoles 2-3m above the ground level

Application form:

Please fill in the application form and return **till June 5th, 2010**. Please express also the starting order for both competitions (1st-2nd-3rd). **If the Starting order field will not be filled in, the order in the application form will be considered as the starting position, i.e. the competitor written as the first will be drawn to the first third of the starting field.**

Organizers will prepare a participant card for each competitor, official and visitor. **Please send the face photos of all participants from your country in .jpg or .bmp format together with application.**

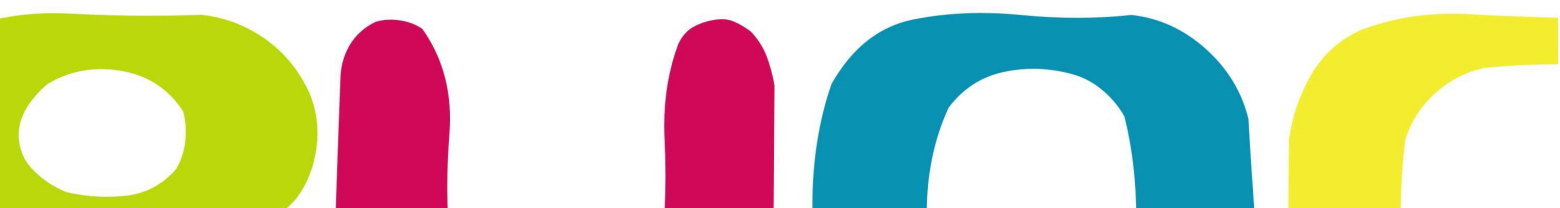
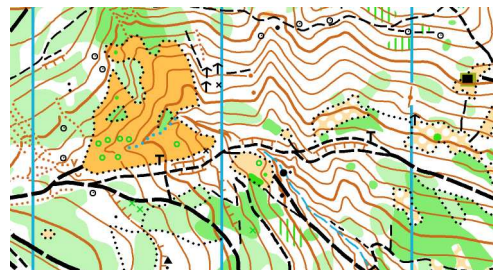
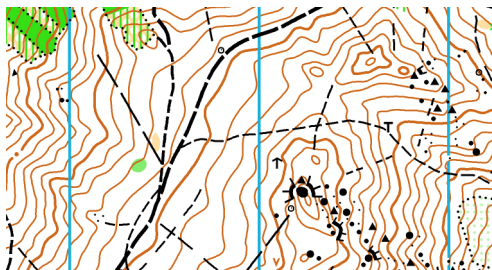
Terrain Description:

- Land form: Located 300-600 ms a.s.l. Gently sloping hills.
- Vegetation: 90% forested (mainly deciduous or mixed forest), 10% open area. Dry underfoot. Almost no undergrowth.
- Runnability: Ranging from very good to good, but reduced in places with denser vegetation. No dangerous areas.
- Visibility: Mostly very good, reduced in some denser areas.
- Green areas: Some green areas (20%). Some nettle, blackberries...
- Paths and roads: Developed network of paths and tracks.



Maps

IOF standard, status autumn 2009, no previous O-map.
Training map close to event centre will be provided for each participant.



Registering equipment:

SPORTident system. Competitors are asked to provide their SI-card numbers in the application form. Those who do not have their own SI-card may rent the SI-card at the registration. The 2,00 EUR rental fee will be required at the registration desk. The rented SI-cards will be collected at the finish after the second competition. Competitors with rented SI-cards who do not return them will be charged for a replacement.

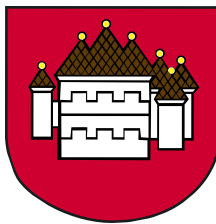
