## Borovets, Bulgaria

#### Dear ARDF friends,

Bulgarian Federation of Radio Amateurs (BFRA) is proud to host **the World ARDF Championships 2022.** It will be organized from **28 August to 3 September 2022** in Borovets, well known resort, located 68 km away from Sofia (60 km away from Sofia Airport).

In the days before that event, namely between **24 and 27 August 2022**, another ARDF competition, so-called **World ARDF Cup**, will be held in Borovets, too, but on different terrains.

The accommodation for both events will be organized in **Hotel Samokov**, one of the best hotels in Borovets <a href="https://www.samokov.com/">https://www.samokov.com/</a>

**BFRA** will organize transfer Sofia Airport – Borovets and back. For groups of 4 or more people the price will be **30 EUR** per person.

**Accommodation** will be in double rooms, but the possibility of a single room is also provided. It also includes Full Board (3 times daily) and use of the indoor pool. The prices **per person in a double room** are as follows:


SportIdent classic system will be used.

Terrain information and map samples are presented below. All maps have been reambulated in 2022. Each map is large enough so that individual sections of it can be used for a separate competition.


### **RELIOVO**

Terrain form	Moderately steep to steep hills. Terrain with micro contours and some stones.
Vegetation	Coniferous forest and open lands.
Runability and visibility	Mostly excellent. Limited in the areas of young pine plantations
Roads and paths	Good network of paths and roads



## **GOVEDARTSI**

Terrain form	Flat to moderately steep slope.	
Vegetation	Pine forest	
Runability and visibility	Mostly good, but reduced in some places with denser vegetation.	
Roads and paths	Good network of paths and roads	




# **MALIOVITSA**

Terrain form	Moderately hilly terrain between 1300 m and 1750 m above sea level
Vegetation	Pine forest
Runnability	From very good to poor – (reduced by denser vegetation and stony fields)
Visibility	Excellent to very low
Roads and paths	Some paths, tracks and roads



# **BOROVETS**

Terrain form	Moderately hilly terrain in the nearest forest to Borovets resort; About 1300 meters above sea level
Vegetation	Pine forest
Runability and visibility	From good to very good
Roads and paths	Very good network of alpine ski and cross-country ski tracks and paths.



# RIDO

Terrain form	Moderately steep terrain.
Vegetation	Mainly spruce forest with some open areas and some thickets.
Runability and visibility	Mostly very good, but reduced in some places with denser vegetation.
Roads and paths	Very good network of paths and roads

#### Weather in Borovets:

The climate in Borovets at the end of August / beginning of September is characterized by clear weather, relatively little or no precipitation and temperatures at night 10-12 degrees C and during the day 21-23 degrees C.

#### Visa requirement:

The citizens of the majority countries, expected to take part in the World ARDF Championships / World ARDF Cup, **do not need visa** to enter Bulgaria. Schengen visa is valid for Bulgaria. Participants from few countries (Belarus, China, Kazakhstan, Mongolia, Russia) require visa.
