1. Venue

Venue: **Veszprém**

Planned period: 1 of July to - 05. of July .2026

Veszprém is located in the valley between the Bakony Mountains, 115 km from [Budapest](#) along route 8



Veszprém, a city nestled where the Bakony Hills meet the Balaton Highlands, is one of Hungary's most ancient settlements. Its historic Castle District offers a journey back in time, where visitors can wander along medieval streets and admire landmarks like the Gizella Chapel and St. Michael's Cathedral. With a history stretching back over 1,000 years, the Veszprém Archdiocese played a significant role in the founding of the Hungarian state.

The scenic Viaduct (Szent István völgyhíd) spanning the Séd stream valley is not only a major transport link but also one of the city's most recognizable symbols. Veszprém boasts a vibrant cultural life centered around its castle and downtown areas. The city is home to numerous museums, galleries, and theaters, offering a wide range of cultural experiences.

In 2026, Veszprém was named a European Capital of Culture, further boosting its tourism and cultural programs. The Kittenberger Kálmán Zoo is a popular destination for families and nature lovers. The city's proximity to Lake Balaton makes it an ideal starting point for exploring the region.

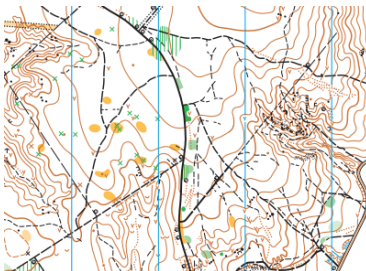
- 01.07.2026 - Arrival, training event, Opening Ceremony

Details of the terrains:



Sprint:

- Terrain: park forest, flat to moderately steep slopes
- Vegetation: well-groomed forest area
- Visibility: Reduced in the dense parts.
- Roads and paths: Good network of paths and roads



Classics:

- Terrain: Moderately steep hills with incisions and stones.
- Vegetation: well-groomed forest area, scattered bushy area
- Good network of paths and road

2. Transportation options

- Via motorway:
 - International Airport Budapest BUD - 145 km
 - International Airport Vienna VIE - 195 km

3. Entry fees

Entry fee:

- 50 EUR per event per person, 150 EUR total for all 3 events.

Accommodation for four nights, with full board, hamfest, participation in all three events:

- 350 EUR per person, for competitors;
- 250 EUR per person, for team leaders, officials and visitors.
